Snow & Weather Conditions

Natural snow

Friday night Low 28F

Saturday high up to 43F

Preparation:

Clean your bases with World Cup base cleaner then brush out with fine steel brush. Start with a layer of PS6 followed by your race wax. Make sure to scrape and brush each layer completely. If your bases are on the dry side do a layer of PS7 before the PS6. **Brush recommendation** T191B fine steel brush, followed by T157B horse hair brush finishing with a blue nylon brush. (alternate brushing option brass followed by nylon). If using a **roto brush** use T0019S steel, then T0016N horsehair, finishing with the T0017W blue nylon brush.

*For racers in waves 5,6,7 consider a more course structure and warmer wax choice

Race Wax:

Glide:

Best option:

Marathon white ironed in followed by PC35; both layers need to be scraped and brushed completely. Finish by applying TST7 with roto wool as a top coat. Alternatively, use a TS7 liquid. Use a fine linear structure.

Solid option:

HS7 ironed in covered by HS7 liquid
(PS7 can be used instead of HS7 for a more budget friendly option)
